Below are the summarised entry requirements as they should/will appear on the university website or advertisement:

7.0 ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

(Normal Entry; Special Entry; Mature Entry; Visiting School; Other.)

Adequately and clearly stated.

7.1 Normal Entry

7.1.1 Five (5) ordinary level passes or equivalent including a pass in English language. Also the candidate must have at least three good A level passes in Mathematics, Physics, Statistics, Biology and Chemistry.

7.2 Special Entry

7.2.1 With permission from senate Special Entry: Students who hold a diploma in Dental Therapy, Dental Laboratory Technology, Oral Hygiene and Higher Examination Council (HEXCO) Polytechnic college diploma in dental surgery assisting/Nursing or equivalent may be considered.

7.3 Mature Entry

Applicant should be 25 years at time of application and should be working in the fields referred to in 7,2,1 above. Applicant may be required to pass an interview.

7.4 All successful applicants will be required to produce satisfactory evidence of relevant vaccinations (currently Covid 19 and Hepatitis prior to undertaking patient care as a registered dental therapy student.
